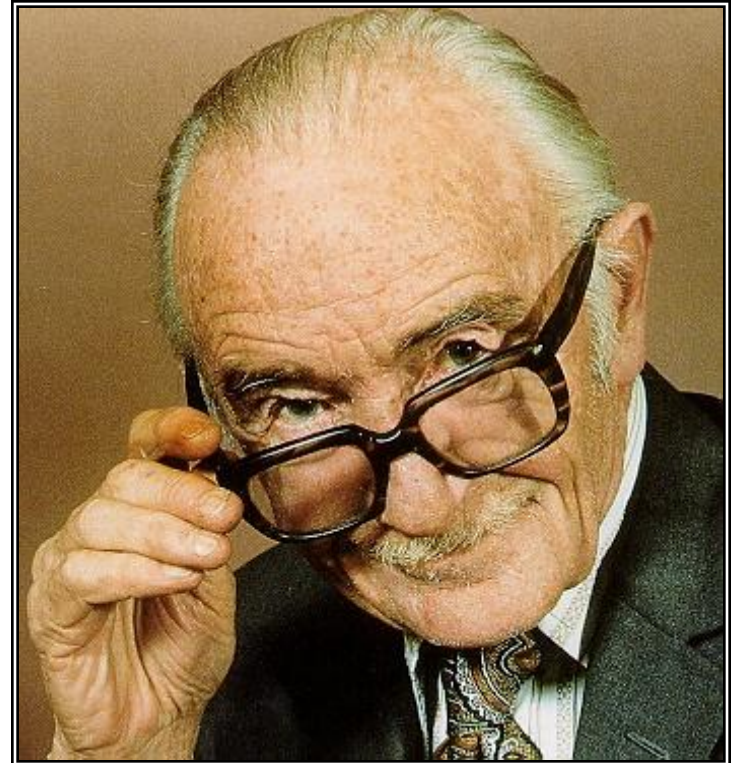


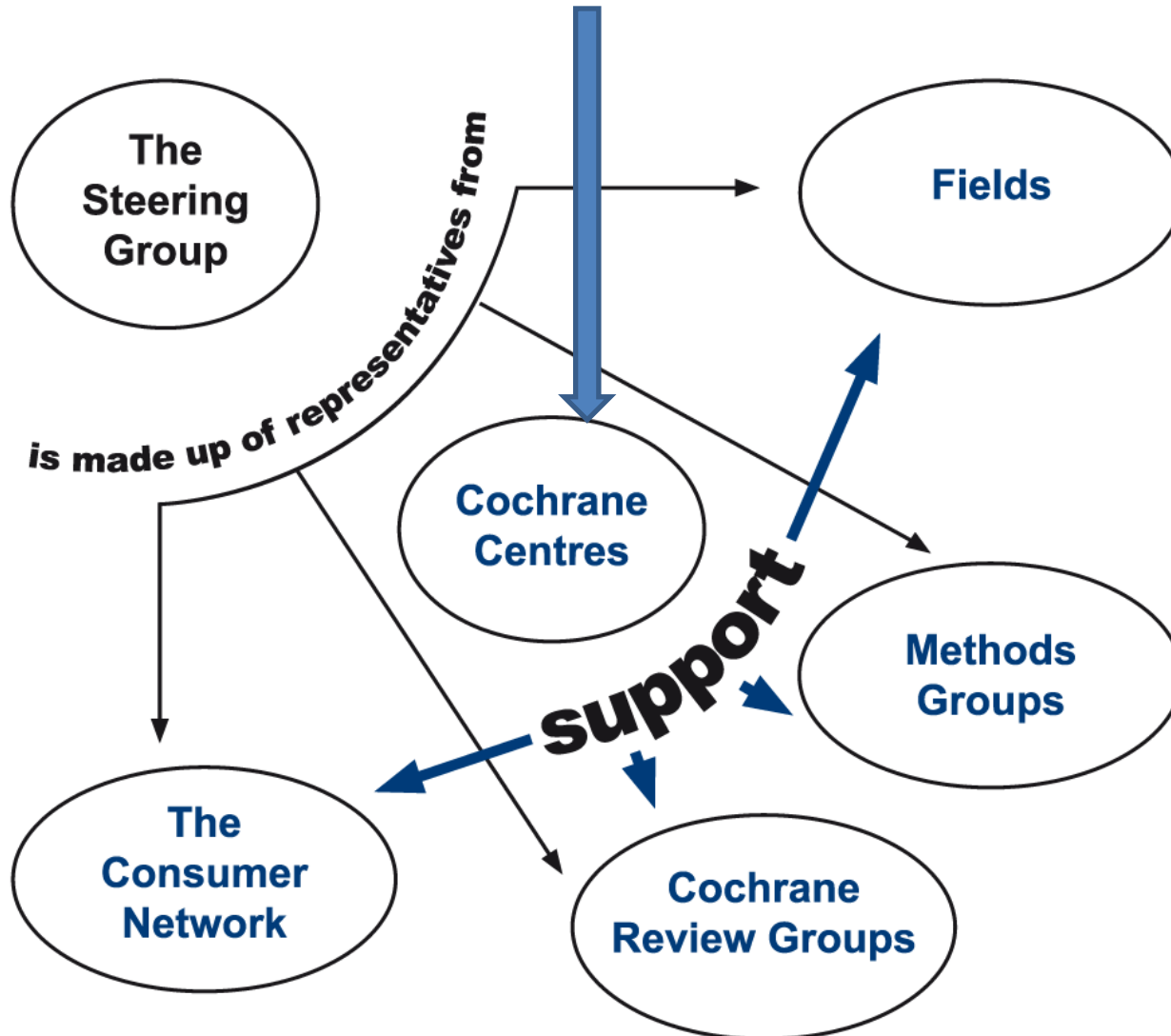
The Cochrane Collaboration

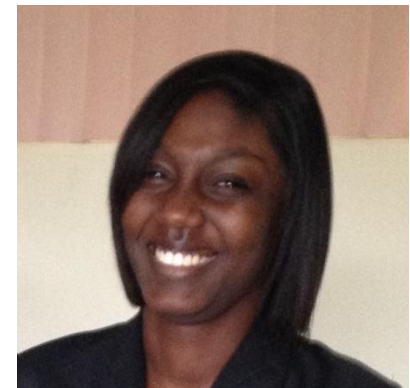

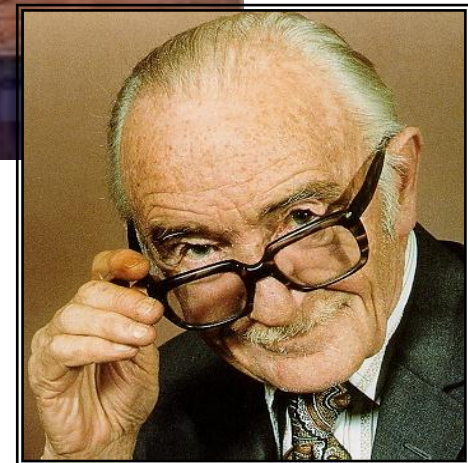
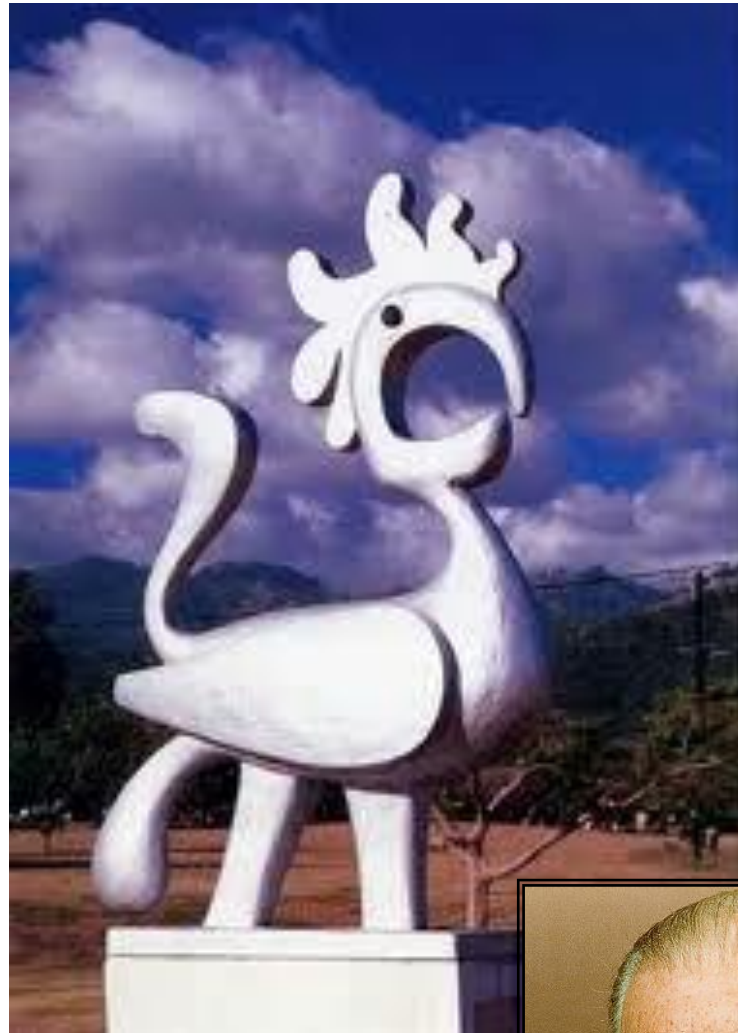
