




What Cochrane is about

- Improving people's health

- Putting the principles of bioethics to good use:
 - Beneficence – learning about the effects of interventions for health
 - Non –maleficence – providing balanced information
 - Justice – promoting equity in health
 - Autonomy – promoting informed decisions
- Cochrane reviews are some of the most visible products, but there are many others including standards, good practices, knowledge translation platforms, etc.



- There is an auspicious environment for research for health





(g) Harnessing Knowledge, Science, and Technology

65. Countries should synthesize, systematically assess, and use knowledge in decision-making to select interventions that are relevant and effective. To fulfill this function in Latin America and the Caribbean, ongoing improvement in the development of the necessary capacities is needed. Moreover, cultivation of local capacity for research and its utilization is necessary.
66. Research should be strengthened to enable a better understanding of the relationship between health determinants and their consequences, to select interventions, and to identify stakeholders that can be partners or can be influenced through public policy.

Interview with Dr. Oscar Ugarte Ubilluz Former Minister of Health, Peru

The Ministry of Health has two cases in which evidence is part of the decision-making process. There are very few documented examples, that is why we are disclosing them. Factors accounting for it could be time pressure, failure to consider evidence as essential and the lack of capacity to translate evidence in a way that it is useful to decision-making.


